The role includes the following tasks:

- Assist in preparing book shipments by selecting titles accurately from a provided pick list
- Support the Operations Manager and other team members to achieve book donation targets
- Contribute to the overall safety of the working environment by following health and safety practices
- Other ad hoc duties as required

- Ability to stand for extended periods and perform light lifting duties, including handling and placing individual books
